

Distribute SMOscan using User policies / Login Scripts per GPO

1. Create a .bat or .cmd file

Content of the Batch .bat or .cmd file:

```
IF NOT EXIST \\SCANSERVER\SMOshare$\SMOscan.exe GOTO END
start \\SCANSERVER\SMOshare$\SMOscan.exe /b
:END
```

Please replace \\SCANSERVER\ with the real SMOscan server name or IP address.

2. Add new GPO

Look for a matching path in the Group policies – e.g. computer accounts.
Then click right on ... create new Group Policy here.
Name the policy e.g. <SMO-Scan Client>.

Navigate to ...

- ...User Configuration...
- ...Windows Settings...
- ... Scripts (Logon/Logoff)...

Click <Logon> in the window on the right and a dialog opens.
In the dialog click <Add Script> to add the batch file SMOscan.bat.

3. Apply the policies via gpupdate /force.

Attention:

If Citrix Logins are not covered by GPOs please edit the Citrix Login Script USRLOGIN.CMD on each Citrix Server
